JULIUS E. MCCULLOUGH MUSIC EDUCATION AND PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP Available to Graduating Senior High School Students 2022 Academic Year

The Tidewater Area Musicians (TAM) a branch of the National Association of Negro Musicians (NANM), has established a scholarship program to support and encourage graduating senior high school students from the Hampton Roads, VA area. This award will be made through the Julius E. McCullough Music Education and Performance Scholarship Fund.

Aim – The principle aims of this scholarship program are to offer financial support to graduating senior high school students who plan to major in music and to elevate the status of musicians in the community.

Scholarship Award Amount – The total distribution support for the 2022 academic year will be \$1,000.

Use of Scholarship – The Scholarship award may be applied toward tuition or other costs directly related to undergraduate study, such as fees, books supplies, and equipment required for courses at the educational institution.

Basis of Award – The Scholarship Committee, comprised of officers and members of TAM, will make the final selection of the award recipient based on their review of the applications.. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of financial need, academic qualifications, and career goals.
