

## **The Julius E. McCullough Music Education and Performance Scholarship**

**Eligibility Criteria.** Scholarship applicants must meet the eligibility criteria listed below:

1. Must have at least a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 grading scale.
2. Must have participated in some form of community service initiative designed to assist others.
3. Must have made formal application to enroll in any four-year accredited college or university, and present verifiable evidence of his or her acceptance for enrollment.
4. Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.
5. Must be a graduating high school senior.
6. Applicant must submit an autobiographical sketch to include:
  - a. Career goals
  - b. Involvement in school, church, and community activities
7. All application forms and attachments must have original signatures
8. Applicant must submit a current photo for identification

**Selection Process:** The Scholarship committee will review each application to ensure that it meets set criteria. The decisions of the scholarship committee are final. All applicants will be notified in writing of the scholarship committee's results. The recipient of the Julius E. McCullough Music Education and Performance Scholarship will be notified of the award in writing. Scholarships awarded are nonrenewable.
